## About Us

Isibane se Afrika is a choir and dance group for change founded in the Cape Town township of Khayelitsha. The group was started by local force-for-good community leader Andisiwe Gaqa when she noticed many of the youth in her township had no positive activities to take part in after school. With no parental overview or adult role models around, these kids fell in with drugs and gangs and Andisiwe wanted to provide them an alternative option to be part of something wholesome and uplifting and so the group was born.

Isibane se Afrika is a registered NGO and all income raised from performances are used to uplift the lives of its members and the local community in Khayelitsha through soup kitchens and more. With mesmerising song, dance, drumming and an engaging interactive performance, the audience is treated to an amazing African spectacle while having a positive impact and doing good where it is needed most. Some of the group's most memorable highlights is performing at an international conference in Poland and performing at the official welcome of the Duke and Duchess of Sussex, HRH Prince Harry and Megan, during their South Africa state visit.

Isibane se Afrika can be booked for performances at corporate events, weddings, birthdays, fundraisers, tourism gatherings and more.

## Our Vision

It is very important for us to reach more of the community. We want to be able to help those in need around us and provide a safe space. Our vision for the future is for Isibane se Afrika to grow in order for us to be able to have the resources to provide educational programs for our youth concerning health and life skills. We want to be able to increase our soup kitchen that we currently have and do visits to old age homes in the area. This support to the community is much needed and will make a big difference.

# Projects summary

Below is an overview of projects for which we require funding support. The list is a mix of projects we are currently running and wish to expand as well as new projects we'd like to get off the ground. More details, along with detailed quotes, can be found further on in this document.

## 1. Centre Renovations & Improvements

Our Isibane Tourist Centre in the heart of Khayelitsha has been a huge success, and has helped us to receive regular tour groups from Uthando as well as other operators. We would like to expand this centre so we have a bigger space for our youngest members, and we need to do some upgrades to the structure itself to ensure it is a safe environment for children. Our dream with the updated centre is to provide learning opportunities for kids where they can improve their singing and learn how to do sewing and bead work. This will provide them with a safe space after school while encouraging them to learn and improve skills

## 2. Youth performance uniforms

With getting our youth involved at the centre, and starting a kids' choir program we need to make uniforms for them that they can wear during performances.

**Amount required: R6,200**



## 3. Sponsor Youth program lunch for a month

Together with the kids choir the youth program will include educational programs to teach more about subjects in school, health and overall extremely important life skills. We need help providing a balanced lunch for them.

**Amount required: R2,500**





#### 4. Soup Kitchen

Our amazing soup kitchen is already feeding a large amount of people in the area each day, but we would like to take this even further. This project started way back during Covid lockdown when we started feeding 200 of the children most in need. Now as our soup kitchen has expanded we are looking at nearly doubling that so we can feed 350 kids. As this is an ongoing project that we have, we are always in need of resources to sustain the soup kitchen.

**Amount required per month: R7,500**



#### 5. Choir Outfits

The choir is in need of an alternative set of outfits that they can wear to performances and events, as the current set is starting to look tatty. Any assistance to help with creating our new Isibane uniforms for our 20 main choir members will be much appreciated. This is important as it will make Isibane stand out during gigs.

**Amount required: R17,510**



## 6. Transportation Vehicle

We frequently have to travel for our performances, sometimes several hours' drive from Cape Town. To ensure choir members can travel safely, we would like to buy our own mini bus/taxi for transport of our choir to and from gigs or busking. This will reduce money spent on transport and we will be able to do more community projects like visiting old age homes, schools and center's that are in need. Reliable transport is really important for work and spreading our message.

**Amount required: R499,995**



## 7. Digital recording of songs

We are planning to digitally record 12 original songs written by Andisiwe, founder of Isibane se Afrika. Publicity is extremely important for us and having digital recordings of our songs will put us in the position to reach a bigger audience.
